To date, our flight program has safely completed over 10,000 patient transports.
- Our flight crews consist of a pilot who has on average logged in excess of 6,000 hours flying helicopters. Our Registered Nurses and Nationally Registered EMT-Paramedics who regularly staff **LifeNet Air** have over 20 years of combined medical experience.
- Our Bell 407 helicopter easily cruises at 140 knots (which is roughly 162 miles per hour) and has a fuel capacity that allows two hours and twenty minutes of flight time between refueling. This powerful aircraft has a maximum take-off weight of over two and one-half tons which allows for larger patient payloads in a climate controlled heated and/or air-conditioned cabin.
- **LifeNet Air** is the only aeromedical provider in the area that can offer a critical care ground transport option when the helicopter is unavailable due to weather or maintenance.
