

On the way to the bus stop, you should walk (on the sidewalk if available).

You should arrive at least 5 minutes before the bus is scheduled to arrive.

At the bus stop, you should take three giant steps (six feet) away from the curb.

You should wait to board the bus until the bus comes to a complete stop and the driver opens the doors

You should never walk behind a school bus.

When crossing the street to get on or off the bus, always cross 10 steps in front of the bus AFTER making eye contact with the bus driver.

Do not bend over to pick up an item in front of the bus without the driver telling you it is safe to do so first.

While riding on the bus, you should sit and face the front.

On a bus, you should speak quietly so the driver will not be distracted.
